Meals

Meals provided will be Snacks, Lunch and Tea.

Lunch will be a hot meal and Tea will be a “snack tea”.

All meals will take into account the child’s likes and dislikes but will have the experience to try new things and develop different tastes.

Hot meals will include homemade spaghetti bolognaises, Stews, Chilli, Lasagne, Jacket Potatoes and lots more..

Snacks will be a variety of different healthy foods.

Water or milk will be accessible throughout the day.

Fees

Hours: 8-6 Full Day= £57.50 per day

8-1/1-6 half day = £30 per day

9-4 School day= £42.00 per day

Late fees: £5 per 15 minutes

Contracts will be issued before sign up and invoices will be sent at the beginning of every month for the month to come. Any payment that isn’t made on time- there will be extra charges. Flexible hours can be made but will need one week’s notice.

2/3 year old Funded Hours will be available, but with a supplement charge on top.

Things To Provide

Suitable clothing, including wellies and waterproofs during the winter months, sun hats and sun cream during the summer.

If your child is wearing nappies, please provide nappies- wipes will be provided.

Formula/breast milk, if required. Cows Milk will be provided.

All children should bring a change of clothes in case of accidents/getting dirty/wet during play.

2:00 pm – 2:15 pm	Snack time
2:15 pm – 3:15 pm	Child-led play/ activities- focusing on child's next steps
3:15 pm – 4:00 pm	School pickup (If Needed)
4:00 pm – 4:15 pm	Snack time
4:15 pm – 5:00 pm	Free Play inside and outside
5:00 pm – 6:00 pm	Tea Time.
6:00 pm	Home time
